

Activity Sheet with a Doctor Who Theme

Note: Although based on Doctor Who the activities have relevance to a range of programme zones and badges.

Other Beings!

Doctor Who frequently has to deal with other beings, aliens/monsters which are nasty, frightening and worrying. Get the Beavers/Cubs, Scouts/Explorers to build a junk model of an alien/monster.

Then discuss with them how they deal with things that frighten or concern them.

A Safe Place

Most of Doctor Who's adventures take him to some dangerous places and this can be frightening. Divide into groups and give each group blanket(s), old sheet(s), ground sheet(s), sheet(s) of plastic, cushions, chairs, string, clothes pegs etc. Ask them as a group to build a safe den with the materials and to make themselves comfortable in the den.

Then invite the groups to talk about safe places they have probably at home. What are they like? Where are they? What makes them special? What makes them safe? When do they use them?

Prayer Tree

Create a prayer tree using the branch of a tree in a pot or a couple of rings (hoops) tied together and include a blow up globe and then hang it up. Ask the Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers to each write a prayer or thought about a concern they have in relation to the world, their community, their friends, their family or themselves.

Hang the prayers/thoughts on the prayer tree and use them as a reflection/prayer during section meetings.
